

IAP Young Affiliate Application Form

Thank you for your interest in joining the InterAcademy Partnership (IAP) as a **young affiliate**. Young affiliate applications are evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Is a young academy, or cohort-based early career leadership program of science, medicine
 or engineering which includes the mission to advance science and science-informed policy.
- Its **mission aligns** with the mission and priorities of IAP.
- It selects or elects new members based on merit through a nomination or application process determined by existing members or a well-defined nomination and selection committee.
- It promotes the **principles of diversity, equity and inclusion**.
- Has **code of conduct** policies and procedures to avoid discrimination, harassment, and bullying in its activities or is prepared to adopt IAP's policies.
- Has procedures in place to review and **avoid potential conflicts** of interest of its leadership, officers, or volunteers who participate in the organization's activities.
- Is registered as a legal entity in its home country or is affiliated with an IAP member.
- Commits to be an active contributor to IAP.
- Its affiliation with IAP is supported by the national or regional academy which is a member of the IAP.

Applications to IAP for young affiliate status should be accompanied by:

- A letter of request for affiliation from the leadership of the young academy.
- A letter of support from the relevant national or regional academy which is a member of the IAP.
- A copy of your young academy's statutes and rules of procedure in English.
- A copy of your young academy's Code of Conduct (if it exists) in English.

This application for IAP membership consists of two parts: **Part A** includes required questions that must be completed to proceed with your application. **Part B** contains optional questions designed to help us learn more about your young academy or cohort-based early career leadership program and its activities.

Once your application is submitted, it will undergo a review process by the IAP Secretariat and the IAP Membership Committee. The committee will evaluate your application and provide its recommendation to the Board for affiliation with the IAP.
